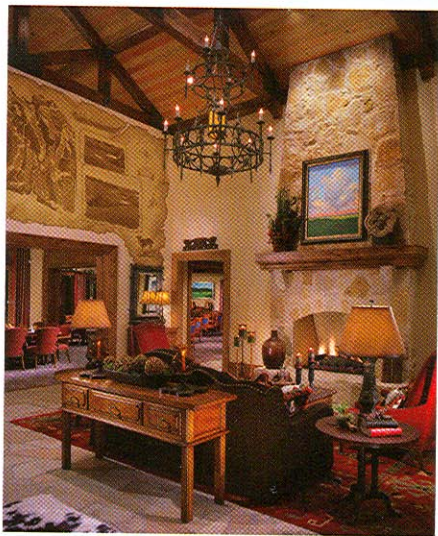

Architect firm awarded honor for Dallas National clubhouse

Golf Inc. Magazine awarded **Richard Drummond Davis, Architect** with one of its top two awards for Clubhouse of the Year in their annual clubhouse design awards. Davis' firm designed the clubhouse facility for Dallas National Golf Club.

The architectural firm competed against clubhouse designs submitted by architects, interior designers, owners and developers from across the nation. After reviewing entries consisting of floor plans, descriptions and photos, judges chose winners for aesthetics, efficiency and overall design concept. One winner and one runner-up were chosen in the category of clubhouses larger than 20,000 square feet.

With its rustic architecture, stone fireplaces and woven leather rocking chairs that sit on a large wraparound veranda, the Dallas National clubhouse offers a majestic elevated view of the award-winning course's hilly terrain. The 24,000-square-foot facility is covered with a native limestone veneer interspersed with



wide windows, and is reminiscent of a hunting lodge in the Texas Hill Country. Additional club features include a mixed grill area to seat 50 people, a 20-seat private dining area, 19th Hole grill that seats 24 people, card room and locker rooms.
