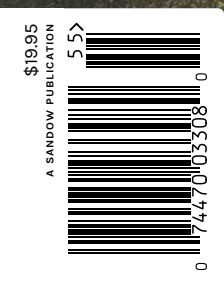
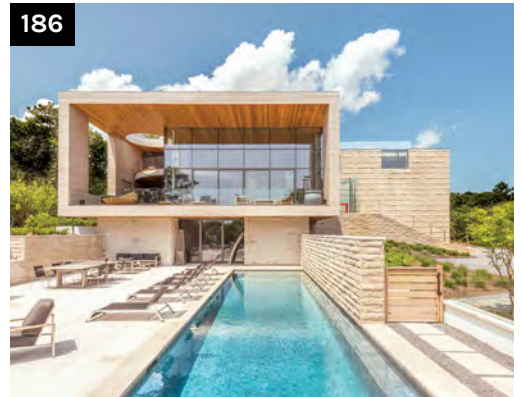
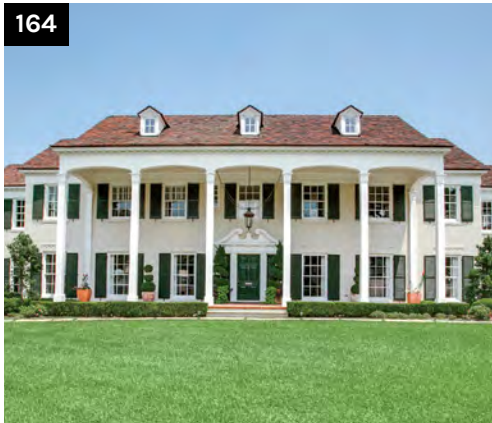

History comes alive when the **award-winning team at Richard Drummond Davis Architects** brings its extraordinary design sensibilities to high-end residential projects that never fail to transport clients.

Creating the architecture of his clients' dreams, Richard Drummond Davis has said, is his life's work. In doing so, the Dallas-based architect has brought the past into the present with an understanding and authenticity in his design that manages to honor the forms and details of revival and period architecture while creating the spaces, amenities and luxuries desired in houses of the 21st century. Along the way, his full-service architecture firm, which he launched in 1977, has earned a national reputation in high-end residential design for integrating the classical elegance of period architecture and clean contemporary design with modern comforts, cutting-edge home technology and the highest quality building materials. "In eighth grade my English teacher asked the class to write about a career," says Davis, a Princeton graduate who studied under renowned post-modernist, Michael Graves. "I wrote about being an

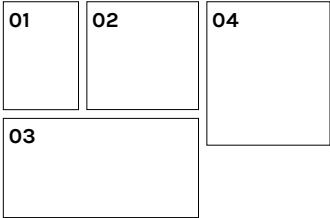


architect. I was always drawing and building things back then. I still do today.” The difference is that, today, Davis and his award-winning team are delivering residential dreams to A-list clients: a Greek Revival home for a Texas governor; a Northern European Baroque-style estate for a renowned transplant surgeon; a French Chateaux-style house for a Texas Rangers pitcher; and luxury residences for three billionaires on *Forbes’* 400 list. Over the years, the firm has designed more than 400 residences that encompass most period American and European revival styles, as well as modern and Texas regional styles.

PAST PERFECT

It is not the size of a project that stirs Davis’ creative passion. When asked to discuss some of his greatest successes to date, he points to the design of an intimate 3,000-square-foot French Normandy manor house in Highland Park. “I look up at the front façade, and I am transported to the Normandy countryside,” he says. Time and again, clients are transported in much the same way through the firm’s beautifully proportioned design, superior craftsmanship and attention to detail. In addition, Davis has turned heads for his equally thoughtful and beautifully proportioned commercial work, including the clubhouse for Dallas National Golf Club, which was done in a contemporary Texas Hill Country style. His unique process, during which he’ll sketch plans for the exterior and interior of a project in front of the client, speaks to the communication and collaboration at the heart of the Davis brand. His team also is involved from initial design through completion of construction, or, as Davis says, until “the last flower is planted.”
